In order for us to access your eligibility for a 30 hour funded place, please supply the following information.

- All parents in the household work the equivalent of 16 hours a week and earn at least £115.20 per week (if over the age of 25) and £107.20 per week (if between the ages of 21-24).
- No one parent in the household earns over £100,000.
- Both parents are employed, but one or both parents are temporarily away from the workplace on parental, maternity, paternity or adoption leave.
- Both parents are employed, but one or both parents are away from the workplace on statutory sick pay.
- One parent is employed and one parent is disabled or incapacitated based on receipt of special benefits.
- One parent is employed and one parent has substantial caring responsibilities based on specific benefits received for caring.

If we are not able to offer you free full time provision, or if you only want a part time place, which provision would you prefer?

Please be aware that there will be a charge for lunch for all children attending a core day. (If you qualify for free school meals, documentation will be required)
